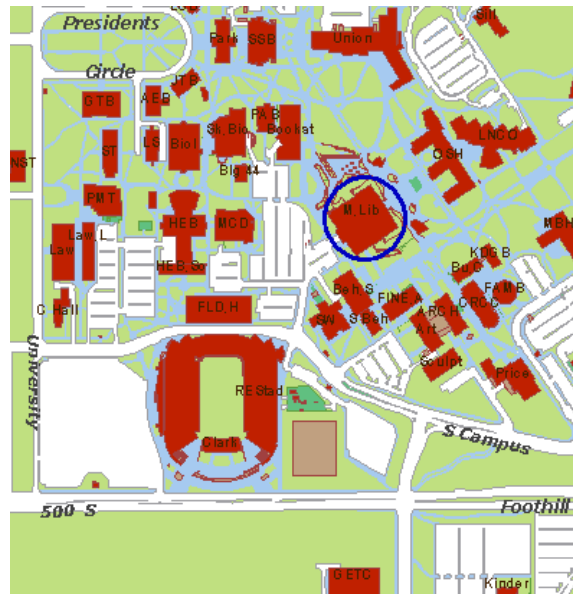


## Faculty Consultations

# Media Services RESOURCES

The Media Services section at the Marriott Library Knowledge Commons has an extensive and up-to-date collection of both video and audio materials.



There are several tables with hands on VCR stations, CD listening stations, and monitors to view or listen to the available collection for class or personal use.

The Media Services section provides equipment for viewing or listening to the collection.

Students may use all of the materials in-house and can check out computer books, CD-ROMs, and audiocassettes for seven days. Faculty are also able to check out materials for class use and are encouraged to meet with the Media Services team to discuss the collection and recommend purchases. Equipment is available for use by faculty with advanced notice. The consultants at the front desk are able to assist you in finding materials and helping with the equipment use.

## AUDIO COLLECTION

The audio collection boasts well over 6,000 compact discs, as well as audio cassettes, vinyl records, and a great selection of boxed sets. There are also foreign language courses, poetry, and even the complete works of Shakespeare available in an audio format. The collection is continuously updated and added to throughout the year. From classical jazz to modern, from string quartets to soundtracks, there is something here to suit everyone's musical taste or to assist in any class project. Both the audio and video catalogs are available online.

## VIDEO COLLECTION

The Knowledge Commons video collection features thousands of films in both VHS and DVD formats. There are documentaries, popular films, classics, children's, foreign language, and telecourses. The collection is both extensive and interdisciplinary, covering a variety of subjects. Documentaries include

PBS specials, History Channel titles, and a wide range of course related topics. The popular film collection includes science fiction, comedy, drama, classics, TV shows, and a vast selection of foreign films. The collection is constantly expanded on almost a daily basis, so it is kept up-to-date to serve students and faculty.
